Scrap Lumber (load first)	Clean, unpainted and untreated wood, plywood, pallets, dimensional lumber and crates.	NO painted or stained wood. NO pressure-treated wood. NO laminated wood or particle board.	Loads will be screened prior to acceptance. Nails do not need to be removed.	Search database [△] for “Wood” recyclers.
Branches & Stumps	Stumps, logs and tree branches larger than 2” in diameter. Leaves on branches are acceptable. Please cut into sections that are 4 feet long or less.	NO yard debris such as grass clippings, sod, weeds, ivy, blackberries, loose leaves or garden waste. NO commercial loads.	Use curbside yard waste cart or Bow Lake Recycling Center for grass clippings, weeds, ivy, blackberries, loose leaves and other small yard trimmings.	Bow Lake Transfer Station & Recycling Center , 18800 Orillia Rd S, Tukwila, kingcounty.gov/solidwaste , 206-477-4466
Mattresses	Mattresses and box springs, any size.	NO commercial loads. NO furniture or frames.	Mattresses must be clean and dry. NO mattresses with bedbugs or major stains.	Spring Back , 117 Puyallup Ave, Tacoma, 253-302-3868, NWFurnitureBank.org
Rigid Plastic	#1, 2, 4 and 5 plastics only: Plastic nursery pots, flower pots, buckets, resin patio furniture, totes/bins and other rigid plastics.	NO VHS tapes, tarps, hoses, rubber, fiberglass, coolers, clamshells, dirty items or soft/flimsy plastics.	Remove any metal or rubber parts before recycling.	
Appliances & Scrap Metal	Large appliances (ovens, stoves, hot water heaters, clothes washers, dryers, microwaves, dishwashers, refrigerators, freezers), barbecues, metal sinks, A/C, gas-powered equipment, and other metal items.	NO car bodies or trailers. NO greasy metal. NO propane tanks. NO vehicle air conditioning units. NO commercial refrigerators or freezers.	Please drain and recycle all liquids. Accepted items must be mostly metal.	Search database [△] for “Appliance” or “Metal” recyclers.
Tires	Light truck, car and motorcycle tires. Rims OK. Steel-belted and studded tires accepted.	NO commercial loads or large/heavy tractor/truck tires.	Limit 10 tires per person.	Search database [△] for “Tire” recyclers.
Electronics	CD/DVD players, VCRs, printers, scanners, keyboards, phones, radios, wires, holiday lights and other electronics.	NO commercial equipment or large printers.	Computers, monitors, laptops or TVs can be recycled through E-cycle Washington’s free program. ecyclewashington.org , 800-RECYCLE.	Search database [△] for “Electronics” recyclers.
Confidential Documents	Sensitive/confidential documents for shredding. Limit 2 banker boxes or 3 paper bags.	NO commercial quantities. NO CDs/DVDs, binders, plastic bags or stiff metal.	Paper only. Material is shredded on-site.	Free Community Shred Events: atg.wa.gov/shredathon.aspx , 800-551-4636
Reusable Household Goods	Small working appliances, pans, books and toys. All dry clothing, shoes and linens, any condition.	NO furniture, carpet or large appliances. NO wet items.	In addition to gently worn clothing and linens, all torn or holey fabrics are now accepted.	Donate to local charity or second hand store. Threadcycle : kingcounty.gov/threadcycle
Styrofoam Blocks & Packing Peanuts	Clean, white Styrofoam blocks and packing peanuts of all colors.	NO urethane foam cushions, expanded polypropylene, foam insulation or used hot tub covers.	Polystyrene blocks only—look for  or  . Please box or bag packing peanuts. Please remove all tape and labels from Styrofoam.	Styro Recycle , 23418 68th Ave S, Kent, 253-838-9555, StyroRecycle.com
Cardboard, Books & Magazines	Clean, dry, flattened cardboard. Clean and dry books and magazines.	NO wet or excessively dirty cardboard or books. NO strapping, packing material or garbage.	Books and magazines will be recycled, not reused. Please flatten cardboard.	Search database [△] for “Cardboard” recyclers. Look for book collection bins in store parking lots.
Batteries	Car, truck and marine lead acid batteries. Household alkaline, rechargeable and button batteries.		Please sort large quantities by type.	Auburn Hazardous Wastemobile* (weekends only)
Tools	New or gently-used tools in working condition.	NO gas powered tools. NO broken or unusable tools—please recycle these as scrap metal.	Tools will be donated to the South King Tool Library for check-out by the community.	South King Tool Library , SouthKingTools.org
Bicycles & Parts (load last)	Bicycles, in good condition or repairable. All bicycle parts, helmets and accessories.		Bicycles are refurbished by Bikes for Kids and given to charitable agencies.	Bike for Kids, BikeforKids.us

WHAT CAN'T I BRING?

- X** Do **NOT** bring **FLUORESCENT BULBS OR TUBES**—please recycle through **Ace Hardware**: 35419 21st Ave SW, **Batteries Plus Bulbs**: 31830 Pacific Hwy S, or the **Auburn Hazardous Wastemobile***. LightRecycle.org
- X** Do **NOT** bring **OIL, GAS PRODUCTS, OIL-BASED PAINT, PROPANE TANKS, PESTICIDES OR CHEMICALS**—take to **Auburn Hazardous Wastemobile***.
- X** Do **NOT** bring **LATEX PAINT** to recycling events or Wastemobile—please dry out, discard lid and place in trash. *Helpful hint*: Mix latex paint with kitty litter, shredded paper, saw dust or paint hardener to solidify it.
- X** Do **NOT** bring **GARBAGE, CARPET OR PAINTED/LAMINATED WOOD**—put in your curbside garbage or take to a **King County Transfer Station**, 206-477-4466 KingCounty.gov/SolidWaste • **Algona Transfer Station**: 35315 W Valley Hwy, Algona • **Bow Lake Transfer Station**: 18800 Orillia Rd S, Tukwila
