- 2. The plans or specification do not call out a material for the rub rail, is a rub rail required? A rub rail is not required.
- 3. The plans call for the bridge to be designed per IBC 2015 and the specs call for the bridge to be designed per the AASHTO LFRD Guide Specifications for Design of Pedestrian Bridges. Can you please confirm the required design criteria and design loading? Design the bridge per the structural drawings, IBC 2015.
- 4. The specs call for a minimum rail height of 42", which is consistent with IBC, however the minimum railing height per AASHTO is 48", please confirm the minimum rail height.
