

Property Owner Electrical Work Permit Affidavit

Applying For Your Electrical Permit

In Washington, only licensed electrical contractors may perform electrical work. Property owners may apply for an exemption from these requirements by completing and signing the affidavit below **before** applying for an electrical permit or beginning electrical work.

	New single family residence that is not intended for rent, sale, or lease, where I will be living for at least 24 months after completing the electrical work. I will be personally doing the electrical work.					
	New 2, 3, or 4 unit residential building, owned by me, that is intended for rent, sale, or lease. I will be living in one of the units for at least 24 months after completing electrical work. I, personally, and/or a regularly employed employee(s), will be doing the electrical work.
