REQUIRED ELECTRICAL PLAN REVIEW

Electrical plan review IS REQUIRED:

- For new or altered service and/or feeder of 1000 amps or greater
- For the following health care facilities:

1. Hospital			7. Maternity home

 4. Private alcoholism hospital

• If the Building Official determines that plan review is warranted

Based on the complexity, hazard, NEC compliance, or other unique aspects of the proposed design

Plans must be prepared and stamped by an electrical engineer licensed in the State of Washington.

Electrical plan review IS NOT REQUIRED for:

• Fire alarm, nurse call, intrusion or security alarm, public address, music, energy management, programmed clock, or telecommunication systems per WAC 296-46B-900(3).



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ELECTRICAL PLAN REVIEW CHECKLIST

Incomplete submittals will not be accepted for review.

A complete submittal must include:

- Completed permit application form.
- Appropriate plan check fee.
- **Two sets** of drawings (11" x 17" minimum/30" x 42" maximum). All sheets must be the same size and include the items shown on the checklist below.
 - Plans to be reviewed must be legible, identify the name and classification of the facility, and clearly indicate the scope and nature of the installation, and the person or firm responsible for the electrical plans.
 - The plans must clearly show the electrical installation or alteration in floor plan view.
 - Where existing electrical systems are to supply additional loads, the plans must include documentation that proves adequate capacity and ratings of the existing service.
