**Description:** Proposal to subdivide approximately 21 acres into 67 single-family residential lots. The project includes street and utility improvements, stormwater facilities, and landscaping. Pursuant to procedures outlined in *Federal Way Revised Code* (FWRC) 18.35.010, the applicant requests preliminary plat approval from the city's Hearing Examiner.
