HISTORIC LANDMARKS COMMISSION MEMBERSHIP REQUIREMENTS

When an application is submitted to the city for landmark review, the King County Landmarks Commission shall meet at Federal Way City Hall. The time commitment for commissioners is generally four to eight hours per month; including occasional site visits, tours and training workshops each year. Commissioners serve without compensation.

Prospective commission members shall have demonstrated interest and competence in historic preservation evidenced by experience in such fields such as historic preservation, history, architecture, planning or other related disciplines.

Commissioners are responsible for the following:

- Reviewing and deciding nominations for landmark designation in Federal Way.
- Reviewing and deciding certificates of appropriateness for alterations to or demolition of landmark properties in Federal Way.
- Developing policy and planning recommendations for Federal Way's historic preservation program.
- Attending periodic training sessions and conferences.
