NOTICE IS GIVEN that the City of Federal Way will conduct a public hearing on Tuesday, March 19, 2019, at 7:00 p.m. in the Council Chambers on the second floor at City Hall (33325 8th Avenue S, Federal Way, Washington 98003) on the proposed First Amendment to the 2018 Community Development Block Grant (CDBG) Annual Action Plan.

Summary

The City of Federal Way's Annual Action Plan details the funding strategies for the Community Development Block Grant (CDBG) program each year. The Annual Action Plans implement the Five-Year Consolidated Plan. The City is requesting to amend the 2018 CDBG Annual Action Plan to allocate additional funding to Multi-Service Center Villa Capri, in the amount of \$48,000, for door replacement to preserve the affordable housing.
