ADDENDUM #2

In an attempt to provide further clarification to the RFB, the City is answering the questions it has received on this RFB below and providing the attached “As-Builts” for the pool and its complimentary components (pumps, layouts, etc.), and the previously built slide (now demolished). These “As-Builts” may not be a complete representation of all components of the pool area, pumps, plumbing, and slide area and the City makes no assertions as to their accuracy. Additional “As BUILTS” for the Community Center that are not directly related to the pool area and ancillary components are available and can be provided upon request. If there is uncertainty as to any of the items or components of the project, depicted or not depicted, please schedule a time for an on-site visit to verify or ascertain any data the “As BUILTS” may not provide.

Q1: List/identify Horse Power (HP) of pump running slide?

A1: Can be found on PL4-00

Q2: List/identify slide users

A2: 48” height and up (children to adults)

Q3: List/identify play structure elements

A3: Proposed play structure elements should be designed and engineered based off of submitting bidder’s professional knowledge/expertise and to meet industry standards. Proposed play structure elements should be listed as plan options that can be reviewed and modified as needed during the final contracting phase.

Below are some ideas that the City would like to see included in bids as options to choose from:

- a double slide onto landing pad,
- water table for play that can accommodate ages 2-8
- additional small elements that have limited splash radius and would not significantly impede line of site for the lifeguards
