**CODE OF CONDUCT**

► **MISSION STATEMENT:**

The mission of the Parks, Recreation and Cultural Services Department is to build a better community through the provision and stewardship of parks and recreation programs.

► **TRAIL USE:**

At all times and at all locations within any park, **pedestrians shall enjoy the right-of-way** over any animal and over any motorized or non-motorized vehicle, bicycle, foot scooter, tricycle, skates or skateboard.

▼ **Each participant is expected to do the following:**

- No person shall travel in a negligent manner or speed in excess of 20 mph. Please use care and caution while sharing a multi use trail.
- Normal travel should occur on the right side of the trail. Any user passing another traveling in the same direction shall pass on the left and give an audible warning.
- Trail users entering or crossing the trail at uncontrolled points shall yield to traffic on the trail.
- Pets must be on a leash no longer than 20 feet at all times and under control. Owners are required to remove pet waste.
